Next steps:

2. **Submit Initiation Fee Payment.** Please call the office at 808-955-4405 for me or Jackie Tanaka, our Membership Coordinator, to facilitate payment of your initiation fee. *During this time, we collect your social security number over the phone for your background and credit check.*
3. **Submit a photo.** Please send a high-resolution photo of yourself (from the waist up). You're welcome to have your picture taken during your interview. This may be published in the *Windward Beat*, our monthly publication.
4. **Send a copy of your photo ID (& marriage certificate, if applicable).** This can be scanned or a photo.
5. **Schedule your group interview.** Group interviews are conducted by our membership committee. Our Membership Chair will schedule this with you.

The Board of Directors typically meets on the 4th Wednesday of the month when they vote on the membership ballot. Once approved, your membership will begin on the 1st of the following month.

NOTE A: Active-duty military members are required to convert to regular or another class of membership for which they are eligible after leaving service.

NOTE B: An associate membership is an individual membership. (WYC Bylaws 2.3, House Rules 2.1.2.(a))

NOTE C: At age 35, an intermediate member is required to upgrade to another class of membership for which the member is eligible.

NOTE D: Non-resident members are entitled to use the Club for up to 60 days per calendar year. Physical presence on O’ahu for more than 4 months (121 days) per calendar year shall constitute residency and preclude this class of membership.

NOTE E: At age 21, a youth member shall automatically become an intermediate member without reapplying or paying an additional initiation fee.

*Adding a spouse provides joint membership in which case only one of them may vote, hold elected office, use parking, or use mooring facilities (except for a single boat owned by both) at any one time.
