## Water Assets Committee

### Policy for Member Use of Club Operated Water Assets

1. Water assets may be operated solely by club members. Such members must be certified for watercraft operation by the appropriate Water Assets Committee member responsible for the asset or his/her designee.
2. No alcohol consumption by the operator allowed six hours before or during the use of any watercraft.
3. A schedule of water assets use will be maintained by the Water Assets Committee and updated periodically as necessary. A copy of the current schedule will be maintained in the Waikiki Yacht Club business office and on the club website.
4. Requests for asset use may be made directly to the Water Assets Committee chair.
5. Water assets for personal use must be signed in and out at the club office in a log maintained for that purpose. The shuttle may not be taken farther makai than channel marker number 8 nor farther mauka on the Ala Wai Canal than the mouth of the Makiki-Palolo stream. The minimum number of passengers required to reserve the shuttle is 6.
6. Water assets must be returned in the same condition as they were taken. Repairs for damage to any water asset is the personal responsibility of the member.
7. All craft should have a minimum crew of two but only the operator need be a member.
8. For the purposes of this policy, water assets shall be defined as the four water craft maintained by the club: The shuttle, the Cal 20, the 'Ilima and the Nadu-K.
